DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Economic interest was mainly centered on a 20-foot wide quartz vein containing some value in copper, gold and silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located in a canyon wall of Wathl Creek, at approximately $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of Kitimat Mission, which lies on the east shore of Kitimat Arm.

The property was staked in 1899 by Messrs. Steele and Dunn and explored by trenching in 1899, 1900 and 1901. By 1907 a 155-foot adit had been driven with cross-cuts of 17 and 24 feet. The property was abandoned sometime after 1909. It was restaked in 1928 for the Cal-Brit Exploration Company, Limited. The company charter was surrendered in 1931 and ownership passed to the Big Slide Mining and Development Company, Limited. No further work was reported by the latter company and in 1949, Big Slide was also liquidated.
