## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The showing consists of a small but persistent quartz vein ranging from 4-12 inches in width, lying in biotite-sericite schist. The vein contains considerable pyrrhotite, but very little gold.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located on the northeastern corner of Princess Royal island, about  $5\frac{3}{4}$  miles north-northwest of the tip of Swanson point. The vein itself is situated at an elevation of about 480 feet.

The Malcolm claim was Crown-granted in 1916 to J. Falkner.

Some tunneling was done on the property.
