DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The two heavily pyritized quartz veins, which carry the mineralization, lie in a country rock of hornblende schist. Mineralization consists of pyrrhotite, massive in places, with pyrite and some finely disseminated chalcopyrite, in a quartz gangue. One grab sample assayed: Au - trace; Ag - trace; Cu - 0.2%.

Interbedded graphite was also found near the beach.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The claims are on the south shore of Kiltuish Inlet, about 1½ miles south from the head of the inlet.

This property was first staked in 1920 as the Payroll 1-2 claims, owned by J. Hickey and partner from Vancouver. Development work from 1920-1922 included trenching, stripping, and a few blast holes.

In 1929, the property was restaked as the High Tide 1-2 claims, by L.W. Patmore of Prince Rupert. No development work was reported.

Associated minerals or products of value - Gold, silver, graphite.
