OBJET LOCALISÉ				<p>The property is located at 1,000' elevation on the south side of the Nelson River 5 miles west of the south end of Kitsumkalum Lake and some 19 miles northwest of Terrace.</p> <p>The Quartz Silver 1-6 claims, owned by J. Apolczer and R. Bates, of Terrace, were under option in 1969-70 to Atlantic Mines Ltd. Additional staking was done in the QF group of 40 claims and bulldozer trenching was carried out. Work in 1970 included a geochemical survey and diamond drilling in two x-ray holes totalling 170'. The owners did prospecting and limited trenching in 1971.</p>

<p>A dacite porphyry contains finely disseminated pyrite and is cut by numerous quartz-carbonate-filled fractures. As exposed in a trench the porphyry locally contains coarse blebs of pyrite, sphalerite, galena and chalcopryrite. The intrusive is cut by a number of narrow quartz-filled shear zones. A chip sample from a 3-foot wide quartz breccia zone containing galena, sphalerite and chalcopryrite assayed: gold, 0.01 oz/t; silver, 1.0 oz/t; copper, 0.2%; lead, 4.10%; zinc, 3.07%.</p>
