The showings are located on Molybdenum Creek, an easterly and southerly flowing tributary of the Zymagotitz River some 12 km northwest of Terrace.

The Molybdenum group, comprising the Gem, Star and Molybdenum claims was owned in 1918 by T. Liard, G. Kerr and J. Erlandsen. Very little work was done.

Canamax Resources Inc held 2,160 acres in this vicinity in 1983.
