DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 1136 A indicates the area is underlain by Upper Jurassic and (?) Lower Cretaceous Bowser Group sediments cut by Upper Cretaceous or later Coast Intrusions. The claims are underlain by tuffs and argillites intruded by a few dykes and a small stock of granodiorite. Quartz veins up to 3' wide in the sedimentary rocks are sparsely mineralized with chalcopryrite, galena, sphalerite and pyrite. A selected sample assayed: gold, 0.03 oz/t; silver, 1.4 oz/t; lead, 3.5%. About a mile to the southeast on the Granite claim (?), a shear zone up to 2.5' wide in granodiorite is well mineralized with chalcopryrite. A sample across a 2.5' width of the best mineralization assayed: gold, 0.05 oz/t; silver, 4.7 oz/t; copper, 4.3%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about 5,000' elevation on the northwest slope of Wesach (Goat) Mountain, overlooking the divide between the headwaters of Douglas and Lorne Creeks, some 24 miles north of Terrace.

The Bermaline and Granite claim groups were owned in the 1930's by A. Martinson, A. Johnson and N. Lundberg, of Ritchie.

A heavily pyritized dyke was discovered by prospecting in this vicinity in 1954.
