DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The Bowser Group argillites and shales (Jurassic-Cretaceous) are intruded by diorites and granodiorites of the coast crystalline complex. The rocks are pyritic. Fine-grained tetrahedrite occurs in a single, massive quartz vein. Free gold occurs in quartz veins.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located in the vicinity of Mount Allard, some 20 miles northwest of Terrace,

The Allard group of 32 claims, located on the northeast slope of the mountain, were held by Rio Tinto Canadian Exploration Limited in 1968. Work included reconnaissance geological mapping and a geochemical soil and silt survey for copper and molybdenum.

On the Misty claim (15 units), owned by Campbell Resources Inc, geochemical soil surveys in 1979 and 1981 outlined a persistent v-shaped gold anomaly with coincident anomalous silver. This work was carried out by a wholly owned subsidiary, CCH Minerals Ltd.

As the result of a reorganization by Campbell Resources and associated companies in 1984 the Misty property (50 units) was acquired 100% by Mascot Gold Mines Limited.
