HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The showings are located at about 4,100' elevation on the north side of Maroon Mountain 5½ miles east of the north end of Kitsumkalum Lake and some 20 miles north of Terrace.

The showings were held as the Alice claim by Paul Broden and associates, of Terrace, in 1930. By the mid 1930's the ground had been restaked as the Guld claim, owned by Oscar Olander, of Rosswood. Trenching was reported.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claim is underlain by Bowser Group sedimentary rocks.

The conglomerate horizon from the Bear and Gold Cap claims extends onto the Guld claim. Close to the line between the Guld and Gold Cap claims is a quartz vein in a sheared zone in the conglomerate. It is 18 inches wide, and 20 feet long, strikes north 30 degrees east, and dips 65 degrees west. Five hundred feet to the northeast a pit has been sunk on an altered dyke that is cut by a stockwork of quartz veinlets of one inch average width. A sample weighing 1 pound and 11 ounces, taken by breaking off quartz chips from a large number of the quartz veinlets, assayed only a trace of silver and no gold.

An assay in 1930 of the vein where it crosses the creek reportedly gave \$7 in gold.
