DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 1136 A indicates the area is underlain by Upper Jurassic and (?) Lower Cretaceous Bowser Group sedimentary rocks. Three narrow quartz veins lying 15 feet apart have been stripped over an area 50 feet in diameter. The veins occur in massive tuff beds which strike south 60 degrees east and dip 10 degrees north. The individual veins range from 3 to 6 inches in width and carry pyrite and chalcopyrite in small pockets. A sample assayed: gold, nil; silver, trace.

The showings are located at the head of Lorne Creek, on the Wesach (Goat) Mountain side, some 25 miles north of Terrace.
