HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the north side of Maroon Creek, several miles east of Kitsumkalum Lake and some 18 miles north-northwest of Terrace.

The Copper Group, comprising 7 claims, the Copperas, Lucky Tom, Lucky Charles, Lucky Mat, Lucky Scot, Lucky Phil and Lucky Bill were owned by P. Chesley, Mat Allard and associates in 1918-19. Assessment work included trenching and blasting.

The showings were apparently restaked in the 1920's as the Crown 1-6 claims.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Schistose rocks are reportedly intruded by a green dioritic dyke or sill. A stockwork of quartz veins sparsely mineralized with chalcopyrite occurs in the intrusive. Chalcopyrite also occurs as disseminations and in veinlets in the adjacent schist over a width of 30 feet. A sample taken across this width in 1918 assayed 0.5% copper and a trace in gold and silver.
