A bedded quartz vein in argillite of the Bowser Group (Upper Jurassic) contains some galena and sphalerite. The vein is from 2 to 6" thick and is exposed along the face of a bluff for 100' or more.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The claim is located at 4,500' elevation on the north-westerly slope of Maroon Mountain some 4.5 miles east of the north end of Kitsumkalum Lake and 20 miles north of Terrace.

The Goat claim, owned in 1921 by G. Moncton, was part of the Bear group (103 I/15, AU 4). In 1926 the Goat group comprised 7 claims, owned by Mr. Moncton and associates, of Terrace. A Crown-grant was applied for on the Goat claim (Lot 6734) but was not completed.
