## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 1136A indicates this area is underlain by Jurassic and (?) Cretaceous Bowser Group sedimentary rocks. In the vicinity of the showings the sediments strike N75° E and dip 20° N. A shear zone 3' to 7' wide strikes northerly and dips 65° W in argillite. The shear consists of brecciated argillite veined and replaced by quartz and calcite, mineralized with pyrite, sphalerite, galena and chalcopyrite, Mineralization is generally sparse except in small rich pockets. A channel sample from an adit across 24" of the best part of a 6' wide zone assayed: Au, trace, Ag 1.13 oz/ton, Zn, 3,8%. A sample from the face of a drift across on 18" width of mineralization in a zone between 4' and 5' wide assayed: Au, trace; Ag 4.0 oz/ton, Cu, 8%, Pb, 4.6%, Zn, 5%.

The showings are located east of the Skeena River, on the lower west slope of Seven Sisters Peaks, some 34 miles northeast of Terrace.

The Hughie group of 6 claims was owned by M. Orr and J.R. Smith from 1925 or earlier. Work to about 1930 included trenching and 3 short crosscut adits each about 50' in length. Two of these reached the shear zone and drift were run for a few feet.
