DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Granodiorite of the Coast Intrusions includes small roof pendants of Palaeozoic rocks. A quartz vein about 2' wide, dipping southwesterly in pendant rocks, contains pyrite, galena and sphalerite. A selected sample in 1927 assayed: Gold, 0.16 oz/t; silver, 21.5 ozs/t; lead, 34%; zinc, 0.5%. At higher elevations these rocks contain veinlets of arsenopyrite over a width of about 50'. Marshall (1926) reported chalcopyrite in the main showing.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located north of Mount Attree, some 10 miles southeast of Terrace. The showings are between elevations of 3,000' to 3,600' in the southeast wall of a basin near the head of a west fork of Eight Mile Creek.

The Lead King group was owned by V. Roy and W. Dahl in 1926-27. Assessment work was done in open cuts.

The Thorn 6 claim (20 units) was staked in this vicinity in 1983 by A & M Exploration Ltd and subsequently transferred to Seastar Resource Corporation.
