DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A well-defined shear zone dips steeply southwest in Jurassic Hazelton group (?) volcanics. The shear consists of andesitic rock and a little quartz mineralized with chalcopyrite, pyrite and arsenopyrite with small amounts of bornite and tetrahedrite and a few specks of galena. A sample across 5' in the lowest trench assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 13 oz/t; copper, 1.1%.

On the adjoining Legal Tender claim a 1 to 2 foot wide quartz vein contains mainly galena. A selected sample assayed: Gold, 0.14 oz/t; silver 58 oz/t, copper, 0.2%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at about 4,900' elevation on the west side of the basin at the head of the center fork of Legate Creek, some 19 miles northeast of Terrace.

Three claims, the Independence, Grizzly and Grand View were owned from 1919 or earlier by J. Burns and associates. B.C. Exploration Company, Limited held an option on the property in 1920 and prospecting and sampling was reported. The owners carried out annual assessment work until 1925. Work to date included open cuts and a short drift adit at the 4,950' elevation.

The Legal Tender claim, located adjoining at lower elevations, was owned in 1919 by J. Burns.
