DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Six or more small southeasterly striking veins have been exposed, and consist of quartz, galena and tetrahedrite. One vein consists almost entirely of bornite. One vein is 3 feet wide, but the others are less than one foot wide. These veins all lie in volcanic rocks. Another vein several feet wide lies in diorite and is very sparingly mineralized. A sample from a 6" vein assayed 0.04 oz/t gold, 61 oz/t silver, 3.6% copper. A sample from a vein containing galena assayed a trace of gold, 5 oz/t silver, 11.7% copper, 9% lead.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The showings are located at 5,100' elevation on the north side of "Silver Basin," at the head of Chindemash Creek and extending to the Legate Creek divide, some 18 miles northeast of Terrace.

The showings were originally held as the Bean Pot group, owned by A. Stewart, J. Bell and associates. Trenching was reported in 1921. The owners apparently restaked the showings as the Grey Copper group of 4 claims in the summer of 1923. The property was known in 1925 as the Coffee Pot group, comprising 8 claims owned by Stewart and associates. The last reported work was in 1926.
