DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The floor of the basin is underlain by volcanics, indicated on Map 1136 A to belong to the Jurassic Hazelton Group. These rocks are cut by albite and lamprophyre dykes. At elevation 4,150' a 12" wide quartz vein outcrops for about 200' along the south bank of the creek. The vein quartz carries sparse disseminations of pyrite and tetrahedrite.

About 1,700' farther east, a 12-inch quartz vein is exposed for about 100'. The vein contains narrow seams of tetrahedrite and bornite. A 13-inch channel sample across the vein assayed: Gold, none; silver 9.7 oz/t; copper, 1.0%. A representative sample of sorted ore from an open cut assayed: Gold, 0.02 oz/t; silver, 71.8 oz/t; copper, 6.6%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT HISTORIOUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at 4,200° elevation in the basin at the head of Chimdemash Creek, some 18 miles northeast of Terrace.

The Silver Basin, Silver Shield, Silver Barrier and Argentite claims were staked by J.D. Wells in 1923. The claims were optioned in 1924 by J. Willman for Seattle interests but no work was reported. Yearly assessment work carried out by Wells and associates into 1928 included open cuts and a 10' adit.

The Red group of claims (Red 19-28) were staked on these showings by Sultana Silver Mines Limited in about 1971. Brent Exploration Ltd optioned the claims in January 1973 but the company spent only \$1,000 on the property before abandoning the option.
