DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by Jurassic tuffs of the Hazelton Group. A brecciated and altered zone between two intersecting faults is mineralized along minute fractures with fine veinlets of pyrite with a little galena and molybdenite. Where trenched the mineralized zone is about 15' wide and contains about 2% sulphide, mainly pyrite. A typical sample of mineralized tuff from the trench assayed: Gold, none; silver, 0.46 oz/t; lead, 0.72%, molybdenum, 0.11% A 5' channel sample in the trench assayed: Gold, none; silver, 0.02 oz/t; lead, none. The mineralization becomes weaker as the zone widens to the north. Some 150' farther north, a parallel vertical fault is bordered on each side by about 6' of sheared and altered tuff containing small amounts of pyrite, galena and sphalerite.

The showings are located at the 2,850' elevation on Tumbling Creek, on the east side of the Skeena River, some 17 miles northeast of Terrace.

The Bradle Bane group of 6 claims was staked on the showings in 1935 by A.A. MacDonald, R.L. MacLennan and J. Preece. Trenching and stripping were reported.
