DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claim is underlain by thick beds of very fine-grained tuff, identified on Map 1136 A as Jurassic Hazelton Group. A sheared and altered zone in the tuff is sparsely mineralized with bornite and a little hematite. A typical sample assayed: Gold, none; silver, 0.36 oz/t; copper, 0.04%. A sample of selected portions assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 0.3 oz/t; copper, 1.6%.
