DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Several shear zones in Triassic (?) volcanics contain lens-shaped quartz veins up to 30" wide, mineralized with a little bornite and occasional specks of free gold. A sample from a 18" wide quartz vein assayed: Gold, 0.06 oz/t; silver, 1.6 oz/t; copper, 0.3%.

The showings are located at elevations of 500' to 800' in the foothills of the northern spur of Kitsalal Mountain some 11 miles northeast of Terrace.

The Poor Group, consisting of the Gold Standard, Ella, Triune and Poor Boy claims, was owned in 1914 by L.A. Moody and associates, of Usk. Trenching was reported.
