DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The property is underlain by Jurassic volcanics of the Hazelton Group. The Montana showings were described as fracture fillings of chalcocite and less bornite and as disseminations in a sheeted zone; a sample across the latter in 1917 assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 2 oz/t; copper, 2.5%.

The Keeler showing consists of chalcocite with less bornite and native copper in veinlets and as disseminations in a feldspar porphyry flow. The mineralization occurs over a distance of 600 feet but is not continuous.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at approximately 5,000' elevation on the southwest corner of Treasure Mountain, some 22 miles east of Terrace.

The Montana group of 3-5 claims was owned from 1914 or earlier by J.D. Wells and associates. Yearly assessment work to 1917 or later was done in open cuts and a 50' adit; the adit was begun in small mineralized stringers which lacked continuity.

Copper River Exploration Company, Limited acquired the property in 1930 and prospecting was reported.

The Keeler group of two claims, staked in 1963, was apparently a re-staking of the Montana showings. Trenching was done by Cariboo Gold Quartz Mining Company, Limited and Bralorne Pioneer Mines Limited, who were doing joint venture exploration on the Northwest property located about one mile to the south.

Glen Copper Mines Limited held some 160 claims in the Snowshoe, Glen and other groups in this vicinity in the period 1966-69. Work reportedly included trenching and drilling on the Montana showings.
