Surface sampling reportedly disclosed a width of 40 feet averaging 1.35% copper, 0.01 oz/t gold, and 0.35 oz/t silver.

The property is located at about 5,000' elevation on the summit of the north spur of Treasure Mountain, some 23 miles east-northeast of Terrace.

The Copper King group of 6 claims was owned by T. Large, J. Dyer & associates from 1914 or earlier.

Copper River Exploration Company, Limited held the Copper King and adjacent properties in 1930; prospecting was reported.

Glen Copper Mines Limited held the Copper King showings in 1966 as part of a group of some 160 claims.
