DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showings occur at the contact of Coast Intrusives with Jurassic Hazelton Group volcanics. A 6 foot wide breccia zone in volcanics about 125' east of the contact is mineralized with specular hematite and chalcopyrite. A sample across the 6 feet assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 0.4 oz/t; copper, 3.5%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showings are located at 2,700' elevation on a tributary of the south fork of Legate Creek some 21 miles northeast of Terrace.

The Imperial group of claims was owned in 1925 by J. Brown, M. Orr and associates. Work to date included open cuts and a 25' crosscut adit which stopped short of the breccia zone.
