DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The property is underlain by Mesozoic sedimentary and volcanic rocks. The Big Boy showing is a shear zone several feet wide in volcanics and locally mineralized with pyrite and chalcopryrite. A sample of this mineralization assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 4 oz/t; copper, 7%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on both banks of Kleanza Creek about 6 miles up the creek and some 13 miles northeast of Terrace.

The Big Boy group of claims in this vicinity was owned by I. Lougheed, of Usk, in 1932.

The Annette claims, owned by John Isima in 1976, were staked in this vicinity on a pyrite-chalcopryrite bearing fracture zone. Geological mapping and geochemical sampling of rock and sand samples were reported.
