DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Map 1136 A indicates this vicinity is underlain by Carboniferous and Permian limestone and Coast Intrusives. The Copper Falls claims were staked on minor showings of bornite and chalcopyrite in quartz stringers in schistose rock. On the Providence group a quartz lens containing tetrahedrite and galena is exposed in a creek bed. Narrow shear zones in silicified limestone assayed only traces of gold-silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at about 1,200' elevation on the north side of the Zymoetz River, 9 miles east of Terrace.

The Copper Falls group of 2 claims in this vicinity was owned in 1914 by J.D. Wells and E. Hamblet, of Kitsalga. Work included open cuts and 2 short adits.

The Providence group, located in the same vicinity was owned in the mid 1930's by G. Bissonette, of Terrace. Work was done in several pits and trenches.
