DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A shear zone strikes N10°W and dips 35°E in red andesite (Jurassic Hazelton Group). The zone is locally mineralized with chalcopyrite, bornite and tetrahedrite in a quartz gangue. A parallel vein occurs on the summit at about 100' higher elevation.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at about 6,000' elevation on the west slope and summit of "Mt. Lindy" some 24 miles northeast of Terrace. The showings are several miles northeast of, and over the ridge from the M & K property.

The Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company Limited held an option on the property in 1928-29. The only work reported prior to 1930 is a 20 foot inclined adit. Assessment work was reported on the Lindy 2 group by S. Reid, of Prince Rupert, in 1928.
