DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The formation consists of northeasterly dipping mesozoic metasediments, including gneiss, schist, and greenstone, interbedded with bands up to 150 feet in width composed chiefly of garnet, pyroxene, and calcite. To the southwest of the property the formation is cut by a large mass of granodiorite and quartz diorite. To the northeast a pegmatite dyke 15 to 20 feet wide cuts the formation. Mineralization in the garnet-pyroxene zone consists of pyrite, pyrrhotite, and chalcopyrite. Many mineralized lenses have been found in the zone but none of them are more than a few feet long, and are spaced far apart. An sample across 4' assayed .05 oz/ton Au, 0.8 oz/ton Ag, 6.2% Cu.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located near the north end of Porcher Island, some 32 kilometres south-southwest of Prince Rupert. The showings occur at about 600 elevation on Bald Mountain 3.5 kilometres south of the south end of Hunt Inlet.

The showings were discovered and staked in 1916 as the Young Bull claim. Assessment work in the form of extensive trenching, a 25' shaft and a short crosscut adit was carried out over several years by Pacific International Copper Company, Limited which was incorporated in October 1916. This work was in part on what was thought to be a wide zonal shear-structure, and in part on a wide unmineralized pegmatite dyke. Ten claims (Lots 6502-6511) were Crown-granted to George Bath and associates in 1922-23.

Noranda Exploration Company, Limited held the Young Bull, Lord Kitchener, Etente Cordiale and Gold Coin claims (Lots 6502, 6503, 6508 and 6510) in 1978. Prospecting was reported,

Dimac Resource Corp acquired a lease on four Crown-grants in about 1980 but no work was reported
