DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claim lies on the contact of Triassic-Jurassic meta-volcanics with quartz diorite of the Coast Plutonic Complex. Easterly and northeasterly striking quartz stringers and veins up to 2 inches in width locally contain auriferous pyrite. A selected sample from one of the dumps assayed 3.5 ozs/t gold and 0.9 oz/t silver.

Associated minerals or products - Silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The Eagle claim (Lot 6513) is located at the north end of Porcher Island, opposite Edey Passage, and adjoins the Surf Point property (103 J/2, AU 1) on the northwest.

The Eagle claim was part of the 19 claim Patterson-Gillett group which was under option in 1917 to Belmont Surf Inlet Mines, Limited. By 1919 the claim had been acquired by Joe Dawson who carried out yearly assessment work until about 1935. Work included numerous open cuts and approximately 300 feet of crosscuts and drifts in several adits.
