DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims lie at a Triassic-Jurassic metavolcanic contact with quartz diorite of the Coast Plutonic Complex. Easterly striking quartz stringers and veins up to 4 feet in width occur in the quartz diorite. The quartz locally contains small amounts of auriferous pyrite and chalcopyrite. A selected sample assayed \$28.40 in gold, 5.6 ozs/t silver, 12.6% copper.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The IXL claims are located at the 500 foot elevation at the north end of Porcher Island, opposite Edye Passage. The claims adjoin the Surf Point property on the southwest.

The IXL and IXL Fr. (Lots 6517 and 6518 respectively) were staked in about 1921 by A.E. Wright and subsequently owned by Wright and H.E. Dennison of Prince Rupert. Yearly assessment work to 1930 was done in open cuts and a 70 foot adit.
