These limestone quarries are located at Swamp Point, on the east side of Portland Canal, 32 miles south of Stewart.

Four claims, the Limestone, Last Laugh, Last Laugh No. 2 Fraction, and Last Laugh No. 3 Fraction, owned by Messrs. Harkley and Moulton, were purchased by the Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company, Limited. Quarrying operations were begun in 1913 to supply limestone for fluxing purposes to the company's smelter at Anyox. In 1916 a new quarry was opened about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the beach. Continuous operations were reported for the period 1916 to 1919 inclusive at a rate of about 4,000 tons per month. Quarrying operations were on a part time basis during 1920 and 1921, and in 1922 the company closed the operation.

Analysis of the lime rock gave: SiO₂, 5%; CaO, 50%; MgO, 2%.
