The country rock on the property is diorite sheared locally and containing much epidote. The rock does not resemble the Coast Range batholith very closely and may be an older intrusive. The mineral showings are quartz veins up to 3 feet wide and well mineralized with chalcopyrite. pyrrhotite, pyrite, and some pentlandite. In the lower exposure the vein strikes about N60°W and dips about 75°NE. In the upper exposure the vein strikes N30°W and dips vertically. The veins locally contain as much as 10% copper.

This property is located at about the 2,300 foot elevation on the west side of the Georgie River, about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the Portland Canal and about 14 miles south-southwest of Stewart.

Six claims, the M.J. Nos. 1 & 2, L.J. Nos. 1 & 2, and Little Pat Nos. 1 & 2, were owned by Jas Lydden, of Stewart, in 1926; open cutting was reported at that time. These claims apparently lapsed. The property held by Mr. Lydden in 1931 consisted of the Montrose group of 4 claims; further stripping and open cutting was reported during the year.

Newconex Canadian Exploration Ltd. held the showings in 1962 as the JO group. Magnetometer and electromagnetic surveys, geological mapping, trenching and sampling were carried out.

Inland Copper Ltd. in August 1973 acquired an option to purchase 28 claims (JJ 1 and 2, C 1 and 4, and JC 1-24) from Joseph Sullivan of Burnaby and Leo Marchaldon of Terrace. Geological mapping and line cutting was reported.
