HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This showing is located at the 2,700 foot elevation on the south side of the south fork of Lahte Creek, about 2 miles northeast of Tchitin Peak and 11 miles northeast of the community of Alice Arm.

Two claims, the Left Over and Left Over No. 2 were owned by J.E. Stark and F.E. Juggins in 1916. No work other than prospecting and sampling was reported.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The mineral deposit is a quartz vein outcropping on the side of a precipice. It is locally 5 feet wide and well mineralized with galena, pyrite, chalcopyrite, sphalerite, and tetrahedrite. High assays in silver have been reported.

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The showings are located at about the 2,400 foot elevation on the south side of the south fork of Lahte Creek, and lie on both sides of a small Creek which flows north into Lahte Creek from the divide at the head of the Illiance River, 11½ miles northeast of Alice Arm.

The Yankee Boy claim was owned by R. Ingraham in 1916; open cutting at the 2,400 foot elevation was reported at that time.

The Glacier claim, located to the west and directly across the creek from the Yankee Boy, was owned by Mrs. Bromley in 1918. Exploration work to that time had been done in two open cuts, and one adit about 12 feet long.

OWNER OR OPERATOR/PROPRIÉTAIRE OU EXPLOITANT

The Glacier View claim, which was apparently located in this vicinity, was reported in 1921 to have a very promising showing.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

On the Glacier claim a quartz vein up to 1 foot wide contains silver ore of good grade. Across the creek, on the Yankee Boy claim, a slight amount of galena and copper mineralization occurs alongside a dyke for a distance of about 15 feet.
