DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

On the original Silver Cliff group the mineral showings consist of quartz veins and quartz-barite veins in hard breccia. At least two of the veins are of good size. They contain pyrite, chalcopyrite, and galena, but sulphide mineralization is very sparse.

On the Titrite group shear zones in volcanic rocks have been mineralized with quartz, pyrite, and chalcopyrite. Small quartz veins contain some galena and sphalerite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

These claims, which extend across the summit between the Illiance and Tchitin Rivers, are believed to be located in the vicinity of the south end of Illiance Mountain, 11 miles northeast of the community of Alice Arm. The Silver Cliff claims lie between elevations of about 3,800 and 4,200 feet on the Illiance river slope; the Titrite claims extend down to about the 3,600-foot elevation on the Tchitin river slope.

The Silver Cliff group, consisting of 4 claims, the Silver Cliff Nos 1-3 and Beaver, was owned by Messrs. Hauber and Hallett, of Alice Arm, in 1918. Very little work was reported at this time and the claims apparently subsequently lapsed.

The Titrite group of 8 claims was owned by John Hauber in 1931 included in this group were the Titrite No. 7 and Silver Cliff claims. Apparently the Titrite group was in part a restaking of the old Silver Cliff group. Exploration work during 1930 and 1931 was done in open cuts and short adit.
