DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The mineral showings are in breccias and augite porphyry underlain to the west by argillites. The augite porphyrite occurs as a small stock. A vein, said to be 16 inches wide in the surface exposure, is reported to be mineralized with chalcocite and to carry low values in silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located at the 4,000 foot elevation on the south slope of Mount Theophilus, 5½ miles east-northeast of the community of Alice Arm.

The Horseshoe group, comprised of 6 claims, the Horseshoe, Primary Metals, Arega, Shamrock, Calumet and Calumet No. 1, was staked in 1922 by Elmer Ness & associates, of Alice Arm. The only development work reported on the property was a small amount of trenching.
