DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The mineral showing consists of quartz stringers with pyrite and chalcopyrite in altered tuffaceous rock. In an open cut massive pyrite is exposed over a width of 4 feet. A sample of the material assayed: gold, 0.02 ounce a ton; silver, 0.2 ounce a ton, and no copper.

This property is located at about the 2,100 foot elevation on the east side of the Illiance River at the big bend, 9 miles east-northeast of the community of Alice Arm.
