DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Bodies of quartz and sulphide occur which appear to be small but which have not been outlined to show their length or width. The mineralization is chiefly sphalerite with some chalcopyrite, galena and pyrite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located on the east side of the Kitsault River about 7 miles north of the community of Alice Arm. Six claims, the Riverside Nos. 1-4 and Kitsault Nos. 1-2, were owned by Messrs. McPhail and Hoskins in 1916. Surrounding these on the north, east and south were 11 other claims owned by Messrs. McDonald, Flynn, Lode and Crawford. Exploration work on the Riverside group was done in open cuts and two short adits. The Devlin Zinc and Devlin Zinc Nos. 1-3 claims were, as far as can be determined, a restaking of the Riverside ground. These claims were reportedly bonded in the spring of 1925 by John Devlin for San Francisco interests. A contract was let for 100 feet of drifting but it is not known what work was done at that time.
