The showings consist of quartz veins up to 2 feet wide in argillite, containing pyrite, chalcopyrite, sphalerite and galena.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

These showings are located between elevations of about 800 and 1,300 feet on the north side of the Dak River, 6 miles northeast of the community of Alice Arm.

The War Dance group of 6 claims, including the War Dance, Grouse No. 3, Betsy, Bute, Whistler, and Badger, was owned by A. McGuire, of Alice Arm, in 1919; the owner had explored the showings by open cutting and stripping. No further activity was reported on these claims.

The I.X.L. group of 5 claims (I.X.L. Nos. 3-7), owned by Mr. McGuire in 1927, was apparently in part at least a restaking of the War Dance group. No work was reported on the showings at that time.
