DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

This occurrence consists of a quartz vein of undetermined width, probably 2 or 3 feet, striking northwesterly and dipping about 50° southwest in massive volcanic rocks. In the quartz are spots of a soft, grey, sericitic-appearing material impregnated with very fine pyrite. A sample of the quartz assayed: gold \$1.60 a ton; silver, 0.6 ounce a ton; no platinum. The owner claimed to have obtained an assay of \$4.80 in platinum a ton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The Rex claim is located on the Kitsault River about 12 miles north of the community of Alice Arm. The claim was owned by Archie McPhail, of Alice Arm, in 1924. Open cutting was done on the vein about 250 feet above the railway and the vein was traced down hill to the river.
