DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The principal showing is a 3-foot-wide quartz vein in a bedding-plane shear in interbedded black siltstones and brown pebble conglomerate. The vein, striking northwest and dipping 45 degrees to the southwest, can be traced for several hundred feet along the steep mountainside and is apparently barren of mineralization except for a 20-foot section near its southern end, where it is cut by a narrow northeast-striking biotite lamprophyre dyke. There, mineralization consists of near-massive lenses of fine-grained pyrite and arsenopyrite with some galena and sphalerite. A chip sample across a 3-foot width assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 0.4 ounce per ton; copper, 0.05 per cent; lead, 0.37 per cent; zinc, 0.15 per cent.

The property is located at the 3,800 foot elevation on the northeast slope of Tsimtol Mountain, 6½ miles north-northwest of Alice Arm.
