DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showings are fractures filled with a mineralized breccia of quartz and country rock. Two or three parallel veins, striking N60°W (mag), and at least one striking diagonally to these, have been found. The chief mineralization in the parallel veins is pyrite, with which is associated some chalcopyrite.

This occurrence is located at the 3,500 foot elevation on the south side of the O'Neill? River, about 7 miles northeast of the head of Hastings Arm and about 15 miles northwest of the village of Alice Arm.

Carpenter's claims were prospected in the early 1920's; little work was reported other than surface prospecting and a few shots put in here and there.
