DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A vein composed of brecciated quartz diorite and country rock can be traced along a precipitous bluff for 100 feet or more. It is from 2 to 6 feet wide and well mineralized with galena, sphalerite, pyrite, and chalcopyrite. Small mineralized cross fractures were exposed by trenching adjacent to the main vein.

This showing is located at the 1,900 foot elevation on the south slope of Kshwan Mountain, about 6 miles northeast of the head of Hastings Arm, and about 16 miles northwest of the village of Alice Arm.

Four claims, the Vimy Ridge Nos. 1-4, were owned by Barney O'Neill in 1922. A small amount of open cutting was reported at that time.
