The country rock is argillite near the eastern contact with igneous rocks, all of the Hazelton group. The mineral deposit is a northerly striking quartz vein 2-feet wide in a narrow shear zone. Seven claims, the Bunker Hill Nos. 1-4, Cougar, Bunker Hill Fraction, and Rocket, were located by J. Calvin, of Alice Arm, in about 1923. Three claims, the Bunker Hill No. 2-4 (Lots 927-929) were Crown-granted to J.O. Tretheway and J. Calvin in 1925. The showings were developed by open cuts and a short adit during the period 1923 to 1934.

The Bunker Hill group of 7 Crown-grants, Lots 927 to 929 and 5806 to 5809, was owned in 1968 by E.A. Trethewey, of Vancouver. Primer Group Minerals Ltd., Wm. Trethewey, President, prospected the claims during 1969.
