DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The deposits lie in argillite near the contact with the Coast Range batholith. On the Silver Wing claim quartz stringers containing some pyrite, chalcopyrite, galena, and sphalerite occur in a westerly striking shear zone. The same minerals occur in small quantity on the Copper Crest claim.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Silver Wing claim is located at about the 2,700 foot elevation on a small creek, known in 1916 as Jones Creek, 4½ miles northwest of the community of Alice Arm. The Copper Crest claim was located less than a mile to the southeast of Silver Wing.

Both claims were owned by a Mr. Jones in 1916. Exploration work reported on the Silver Wing consisted of open cuts and two short adits.
