A quartz vein 4 to 12 inches wide strikes S20°W and dips 60° northwest in argillite. In places the vein is said to be solid sulphides, consisting of pyrite, galena, and sphalerite. High silver assays have been reported.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Mimico property is located at the 1,000 foot elevation on Glacier Creek, about 4½ miles northeast of Stewart.

Four claims, the Mimico, Mimico No. 2, Rivereer, and Second Relief, were reported to have been staked in about 1916 and acquired in 1919 by H.O. McClymont and A. Aldridge. Work done on the showings to 1923 included open cutting and about 175 feet of drifts and crosscuts in one or more adits. Mimico Mines, Limited was formed in July 1925 to acquire the property; no development work was reported done by the company; the company charter was surrendered in December 1931.
