### DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rocks are volcanics of the Hazelton group. Two parallel quartz veins about 400 feet apart strike easterly into the hill. The south vein is sparingly mineralized with pyrrhotite and traces of galena. An average sample across 54 inches in the face of an open cut assayed 20¢ a ton in gold. \$3.43 a ton in silver, and 1.61% lead. The north vein shows about 9 feet in width of quartz sparsely mineralized with pyrrhotite. A chip sample across this assayed 20c a ton in gold, and 7¢ a ton in silver (all of the above assays are at 1925 prices).

This occurrence is located at the 3,200 foot elevation north of the north fork of Portland Creek, about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles southeast of Stewart. The Silverado property adjoins to the south.

The occurrence was apparently staked by J. Haahti and H. Hill, of Stewart. Gold Ore Mining Company, Limited was formed in February 1925 to acquire the Eagle group of 4 claims, the Eagle No. 1. Eagle No. 3 Fraction, Eagle Fractional No. 4 and Babe No. 2 claims. Three of the claims expired in June and July 1925 and were restaked by the original owners, leaving the company one fractional claim, the Eagle Fractional No. 4. No work other than a little open cutting has been reported on this occurrence.
