DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The northwesterly striking contact between granodiorite of the Coast Range intrusives on the southwest and volcanics rocks of the Hazelton group on the northeast cuts across the property. Several quartz veins occur on the property: One of the veins varies from a few inches to 14 inches in width and is sparsely mineralized with pyrite, sphalerite and traces of galena; another vein, striking northwest and dipping steeply, has been exposed at the 4,000 foot elevation. This vein is fairly wide but is only very sparsely mineralized with pyrite and chalcopyrite; a third occurrence is a small and nearly vertical east-west vein. It is only a few inches wide but is said to carry good gold and silver values.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This occurrence is located at about the 4,000 foot elevation on the east side of Portland Canal, 3 miles south-southeast of Stewart. The claims are adjoined on the north by the Silver Bell group and on the east by the Aberdeen group.

The Silver Shoe group of 6 claims, recorded in the name of J.J. Haahti, W. Noble, and H. Hill, was apparently located in the early 1920's. Silver Slipper Mining Company, Limited was formed in 1925 to acquire the property. Some exploration work was done in open cuts and a short adit. The company charter was surrendered in 1928.

The above claims apparently lapsed and the ground was restaked as the Silver Hill Nos. 1-6 claims. Coast Silver Mines Limited, which was registered in British Columbia in October 1928, apparently acquired the claims at that time. Little, if any, exploration work was done by the company on this occurrence.
