The Melvin group is located at about the 4,500 foot elevation on the east side of Mount Rainey, $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles southeast of Stewart. The claims lie northeast of and adjoining the Porter-Idaho property.

The Melvin group of 4 claims was owned and prospected by N.H. Stevens, of Hyder, Alaska, from about 1925. The Melvin Syndicate was formed in September 1928 to assume ownership of the claims. Marmot Metals Mining Company, Limited optioned a part interest in the syndicate in 1928.

Melvin Mining Company, Limited was formed in January 1929 to acquire the property. Five claims, the Melvin, Melvin 1, 2, and 4 Fractions, and Melvin No. 3 (Lots 1867-1870 and 4727) were Crown-granted to H.W.M. Rolston in 1929. Exploration work on the property was done in a 40 foot long drift with a winze 20 feet from the portal. A small shipment of ore was made from these workings. The company charter was surrendered in 1932.

In 1929, 4 tons of ore were shipped from this property. From this ore 776 ounces of silver were recovered.
