DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The marl deposits occur on a gravel bench. One deposit occurs in a shallow lake about 600 feet long and 300 feet wide. Some 400 feet farther northeast, marl has completely filled what was formerly a small lake basin over an area about 300 feet in diameter and to an average depth of about 6 feet; the marl is covered by a foot of peat.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This deposit is located at the 1,000 foot elevation on the north side of the Skeena River some 28 miles southwest of Hazelton and about 1 mile north of Wilson Creek.

The Gee Kid claim was staked by J.H. Reid, of Woodcock, in 1936. Numerous test pits were sunk on the deposit.
