DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rock is argillite. Boulders of copper ore up to 2 feet in diameter have been found on the property, but are reported to have a greenstone gangue and, therefore, did not come from the area covered by the Homestake group. Considerable stripping has been done on a basic dyke slightly mineralized with pyrite and occasionally some chalcopyrite. A selected sample of the best mineralization seen assayed: gold, trace; silver, trace; copper, nil.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The Homestake group is located on Granby Bay about 1½ miles southwest of Anyox. The group of 3 claims was staked in 1910 and Crown-granted in 1914. Considerable stripping and ground sluicing was done by the owner, Mr. McRostie, of Anyox, in an effort to locate the source of a number of large boulders of ore found in a small creek flowing across the claims. The last reported work by Mr. McRostie was in 1931 when considerable stripping was done on a slightly mineralized basic dyke.

The Home Stake No. 1 claim (Lot 1529) was Crown-granted in 1915 to J.L. Hatch.
