HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located about 8 km NW of the Anyox  
townsite.

The Consolidated Mining & Smelting Company of Canada  
Limited staked the property in 1953, apparently as the Ed  
group. Work on the Ed and Double Ed (103 P/5, CU 6) during  
the year included geophysical surveys, trenching, and 3,905  
feet of diamond drilling. During 1954 a total of 4,182  
feet of diamond drilling was carried out on the Eden.  
Reserves have been reported at 226,800 tonnes averaging  
2.0% copper (Geological Fieldwork, 1985, p. 213).

The Company name was changed in 1966 to Cominco Ltd.
