This occurrence is located at the 1,600 foot elevation north of Falls Creek, about 1 mile from the Utopia property and 1¼ miles northwest of the community of Alice Arm.

The Billy Barton group of 6 claims was owned in 1929 by J. Peacock and T. Calfa. Exploration work to this date had been done in a 90 foot long adit and 2 short crosscuts.
